Final Call for Contributed Papers and Posters

Deadline for Submissions – April 6, 2017 by 5:00pm MT

We invite submission of abstracts for oral and poster presentations at the 2017 Deer and Elk Workshop. This workshop is sanctioned by the Western Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies and is being hosted by the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. Papers and posters will be selected based on their relevance to research and management of deer and elk and their habitats.

Full Presentations & Posters

Abstracts for full presentation and poster submissions should conform to the following:

- submitted electronically as an MS Word (or compatible) email attachment to Shane Roberts at shane.roberts@idfg.idaho.gov
- include the words “Deer and Elk Workshop Abstract” in the email subject line
- state whether it is a “Full Presentation” or “Poster”
- abstract of < 250 words, in Times New Roman 12pt font, that summarizes the objectives, methods, results, and conclusions/management implications
- follow the format of the example submission below, including indicating whether you intend to submit an associated manuscript for inclusion in a peer edited Symposium Proceedings (manuscripts due on May 1, 2017)

Full oral presentations will be scheduled for 20 minutes, with 15 minutes for presentations and 5 minutes for questions. A laptop PC and projector will be provided for PowerPoint presentations. Please inquire about other A/V aids if needed. Abstracts not accepted for a full presentation may be assigned to the To-The-Point (see below) or Poster sessions with consent of the submitter.

Posters will be displayed from the Tuesday evening social through the Wednesday banquet, but only need to be attended by the author during the Tuesday social. Each poster must be contained within a 4 ft x 4 ft area.

“To-The-Point” Presentations

New this year, we are offering an alternative to the full, 20-minute oral presentation for subjects that can be covered in a shorter time (e.g., progress reports on ongoing research/management, notes from the field, etc). “To-The-Point” presentations are allotted 10 minutes with no time for questions (those with questions are encouraged to discuss with presenters during breaks or socials). Presenters in this rapid-fire session are encouraged to keep their talks to 10 slides or less and practice to make sure it fits within the allotted time. Trying to present a PowerPoint developed for a 20-minute timeslot will not work and our moderator will strictly enforce time limits to keep this session on schedule. For those interested in presenting during the “To-The-Point” session, you need only submit your name, contact information, presentation title, and a brief presentation description (2-3 sentences) by email to Shane Roberts (shane.roberts@idfg.idaho.gov). Please put “Deer and Elk Workshop To-The-Point” in the subject line of the email.
